Our team of Australian and international consultants work together to design course materials that promote diversity and inclusion.

Some digital tools we use include Google Meet, Zoom, Padlet and Flip. Online delivery provides flexibility for our partners.



FAQs

How can I meet with the QI team?

When do QI courses run?

We typically deliver training programs from February through to November each year. The peak training period is from June to September. We work with you to agree on dates that suit your institution.

Can individuals enrol in QI courses?

No, we work with groups within organisations. You can organise a small group of colleagues and enrol in a program together, with up to 20 participants per class.

Are QI courses offered online?

Yes, we deliver many of our courses as LIVE and interactive, online training via Zoom or Google Meet. Our modules are designed for flexibility and combine face-to-face and self-paced learning activities.

Does QI offer training courses in Brisbane?

Yes, we have some capacity to support group professional training in Brisbane, in collaboration with our local school and university partners.

How much does a QI training program cost?

To maintain best practice, our training programs are costed on a per class basis with a maximum of up to 20 participants in one class. Talk to us about our fees and pricing structure.
